PRICING AND PAYMENT

Rates apply to all schools (public, private, charter and home schools) visits during the month of May and first week of June 2026. Advance reservations are required at least 21 days prior to schools choice date. GOODTIME III may not be able to accommodate school's first choice date please plan to have alternate dates.

- **ADMISSION COSTS**

\$12 for students in grades K-8th

FREE for Teachers, faculty staff members, and instructional and non instructional staff members with valid school ID- All staff members will need to show School ID.

- **CHAPERONES**

GOODTIME III will be limiting chaperones to two (2) per class unless otherwise discussed with the School Field Trip Coordinator. The cost for chaperones is \$30 and must be paid through the school. GOODTIME III will not be having walk up ticket sales on the day of for security and safety reasons. The role of the chaperone is to supervise the students; they are an extra set of eyes. We suggest teachers create groups for each adult to supervise during the cruise. We see too many chaperones not supervising the students during the cruise. Our crew are not to be supervising the students. Our crew is there to carry out their daily duties and make sure all are safe. They will speak with the teacher or chaperone if students are not following GOODTIME III safety rules, they are not there to enforce it, this is the role of the teacher and chaperone.

- **PAYMENT**

Payment is due 7 days prior to the cruise date. ALL PAYMENTS ARE NON-REFUNDABLE. Preferred payment method is Credit Card, School issued check or Cash at the window. If a school prefers to pay with a Purchase Order, then it is the teacher's responsibility to obtain that purchase order and provide it to GOODTIME III prior to their cruise or they will not be permitted to board. The School Field Trip Coordinator will provide you with the email address to where to send a copy of the Purchase Order prior to your school field trip date. The original Purchase Order will need to be brought to the GOODTIME III ticket office on the day of the cruise if the district has not yet sent payment for the cruise. GOODTIME III is not responsible for obtaining and making sure a

Purchase order was received. The teacher is responsible for this and should follow up with GOODTIME III sooner rather than later to see if we received the copy of the Purchase Order.

PARKING

- Bus Parking will be available behind the Huntington Bank Stadium located at 101 Erieside Avenue.
- Large School buses are not permitted onto the pier where GOODTIME III is located at. School Buses will drop their passengers off at the cul-de-sac prior to entering E 9th street pier.
- If bus drivers are cruising aboard GOODTIME III they will pay for parking at the above-mentioned lot by scanning the QR code upon entering that lot and paying with a credit card ONLY. It will be around \$36-40 per bus.
- Vehicles and 10-passenger vans are permitted to park on E 9th Street lot located at 825 E 9th Street Pier (where GOODTIME III is docked). A fee of \$11-\$13/vehicle will be paid for at KIOSKS with a credit card only. All spots are first come first served.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- Teachers are to check in at the ticket office prior to boarding GOODTIME III
- Teachers will provide the ticket office with accurate headcount of students, teachers, staffing and chaperones. PLEASE DO A HEADCOUNT BEFORE GETTING OFF THE BUS.

FORMS OF PAYMENT: CASH, CREDIT, SCHOOL CHECK AND PURCHASE ORDER. (Schools will not be permitted to board if payment/purchase order is not made/provided 7 days prior to cruise date)

RULES & REGULATIONS: *Safety is PRIORITY!* Students MUST be supervised by teachers/chaperones the entire time they are aboard the ship. No running or horseplay is permitted. Teachers and Chaperones are responsible for the behavior and safety of their students. Students are expected to be kept seated and quiet during the narration (as they would be in a classroom).

DROP OFF/PICK UP PROCEDURE: Buses are NOT PERMITTED to come onto the pier. Please drop off at the roundabout. GOODTIME III suggests schools be in the area by 9:45am. After dropping off, buses may park at the parking lot located at 101 Erie side Ave. Please plan accordingly if the bus driver plans to ride the boat and arrive earlier as it is a 10 minute walk from that lot to GOODTIME III. Bus Parking fee is \$36 IF THE DRIVER LEAVES THEIR BUS. This fee is payable with a credit card at the lot on the day of. (QR code will need to be scanned in order to pay for parking) Map available upon request
